

S.A.V.E. Business Recycling Guide - Helena

Standard Materials	Please note the following guidelines when preparing recyclables.
Aluminum	Empty and clean. Clean foil ok.
Plastics	<p>Clear Plastics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #1 PETE bottles – water bottles, soda bottles, etc. • #1 PETE <u>clear</u> clamshells/trays – fruit containers, etc. <p>Colored Plastics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #2 HDPE colored bottles – laundry detergent bottles, white milk jugs etc. • #2 HDPE natural bottles – translucent milk jugs <p>Non-traditional Plastics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #3-#7s • No PVC pipe, light film, Styrofoam or motor-oil containers. <p>*Always remove lids & discard dirty items. Collection setup varies depending of materials generated by business.</p>
Metal Cans	Empty and clean.
Glass	Labels are okay. Metal lids can go with cans (above). No plates or auto.
Corrugated Cardboard	Brown paper bags are okay. Always flatten boxes.
Newspaper, Catalogs, Magazines, Office Paper	Windowed envelopes and colored paper are okay. No Goldenrod. Set large catalogs to side or ripe binding to 1/4 " thick.
Non-standard Materials	Call to arrange for pickup. *Additional fees may apply.
Electronics	Nearly all office electronics can be recycled. Call our office for more info.
Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs),	Please keep intact.
Fluorescent Light Bulbs	Please store in products original box or call ahead if loose lighting tubes set aside for recycling.
Cell Phone, Print Cartridges	They items can always be collected by S.A.V.E.
Rechargeable Batteries	From cell phones, power tools, etc. Tape battery leads or use zip-lock.
Household Batteries	AA's C's etc. *Additional 99 cents / lb.
